	Make your due date at least one week before the drop-dead due date of February 11 at 2:00 pm. We must receive registrations on or before Feb. 11 at 2:00 pm. Send your forms early to secure your spots!
	Keep copies of all the registration forms.
	Make check payable to Diocese of Kalamazoo with 'THE PRESENCE' in the memo
	Send all forms together with payment to: Diocese of Kalamazoo - THE PRESENCE 215 North Westnedge Ave. Kalamazoo, MI 49007
	Please note that the adult chaperone-to-student ratio is determined by the overnight cabins. For each group, there must be a minimum of two chaperones. Please refer to the FEMALE and MALE CABIN forms to confirm the appropriate chaperone-to-student ratio.
	The following ratios apply to the ten beds in the Male cabins: - 1-4 boys: 1 male chaperone (a group will be assigned to share a 10-person cabin) - 5-8 boys: 2 male chaperones
	The following ratios apply to the twelve beds in female cabins: - 1-5 girls: 1 female chaperone (a group will be assigned to share a 12-person cabin) - 6-10 girls: 2 female chaperones
۵	If your group decides to merge with another group and share chaperones, you will become one group. In this case, all forms and fees should be sent under one group name.
	If your group does not fill half of the cabin, another group will be assigned to that cabin to fulfill the adult/student ratio. However, the groups will not merge; they will merely share cabins to achieve the required ratio.
<u> </u>	Last-minute cancellations will not have their registration fee refunded. If a student cancels after your group has registered, you can fill that spot with another student. Email thepresencekalamazoo@gmail.com or call Susie at 269-226-0064 to make the change.
	A fine of at least \$100 will be issued to the Group if any one person in the group damages the property.
	As the GROUP LEADER, you are responsible for submitting the "Chaperone Verification Form". The Group Leader must secure the signature of the Parish Safe Environment Coordinator verifying each adult chaperone. The Chaperone Verification Form is included in this packet.
ū	The retreat ends AFTER Sunday Mass, at approximately 12:30 pm. The Sunday 11:00 am Mass is for retreat attendees only.

WELCOME

- High School students, grades 9th 12th, and Adult Chaperones.
- High school students attend with an organized group facilitated by chaperones.

COST

- \$150 per person.
- Registration closes on February 11 at 2:00 pm.

- Please do NOT call Camp Geneva with questions in regards to the retreat. Do NOT mail forms to Camp Geneva.

WHEN

- 6:00 pm, Friday, February 27, through 1:00 pm, Sunday, March 1.
- All students and chaperones are required to stay on the premises for the entire retreat.
- Students cannot leave the premises and re-enter under any circumstances.
- Chaperones are required to stay with students the entire retreat, 6:00 pm Friday 1:00 pm Sunday. All day and all night.
- No late arrivals, such as planning to arrive at 10:00 pm or arriving during the day on Saturday. Participants may not leave to attend to another obligation and come back.

MEALS

- Snack served at 10:00 pm on Friday.
- All Saturday meals will be provided.
- Breakfast is served on Sunday.
- Please list on the Medical Form any dietary requirements.

CLOSING MASS

- Sunday at 11:00 am
- This Mass is only for retreat attendees. This Mass will not be open to the public.

CHECK-IN

- Friday 6:00 pm.
- No late arrivals, except for circumstances beyond our control: getting lost, car trouble, weather, etc.
- Balance must be paid in full, and all required documents must be submitted to The Presence before the retreat.

SLEEP AREAS

- Every group is required to have a chaperone(s) of the same gender.
- Everyone will sleep in bunks. Bring bedding. Do NOT bring cots or air mattresses.
- Groups will be split by gender. There will be female cabins and male cabins.

SHOWERS

- Girls have a full bathroom and shower in the bunkhouse.
- Boys have a full bathroom and shower in the bunkhouse.

PACKING LIST

- Sleeping bag or bedding for a twin-size bed
- Pillow
- Towel
- Toiletries
- Cinch Sack
- Comfortable change of clothes
- Clothing for walking outdoors
- Kneeler pad/bleacher seat cushion
- Rosary
- All medications must be carried by the Group Leader or Chaperone.

ATTIRE

- Please dress comfortably in indoor attire.
- Bring a coat! We will be going outside during transitions.
- In general, we ask that participants dress following a general sense of Christian decency.
- No tight yoga pants, please.

CELL PHONES

- Cell Phones or any other electronic devices are not allowed while program activities are in session.
- The Presence is not responsible for any lost items.

MEDICATIONS

- The Presence volunteers will not dispense medication during the retreat.
- Chaperones are responsible for dispensing medication to their students. Students may not carry medications per Diocesan policy.

Who is Who?

A STUDENT is...

- 9th 12th grader
- Not an 8th grader. Sorry, no exceptions.
- Committed to arriving by 6:00 pm on Friday and staying until 1:00 pm Sunday.
- Someone who understands, except in an emergency, that they cannot leave the premises during the retreat.
- Someone who will not leave to attend another event and return to the retreat.

The GROUP LEADER is...

- The person in communication with The Presence Committee.
- Responsible for communicating information and policies to Chaperones and Students.
- Responsible for verifying Chaperone Virtus certification and Criminal Background Check.
- Responsible for securing an adult-to-student ratio.
- The Group Leader does not have to attend but must be available by phone during the retreat.
- The Presence Committee will not secure chaperones for your group. If you connect with another group to share chaperones, then you merge as a group. All the forms and fees should be mailed under ONE group name. Upon arrival at the retreat, everyone in your group (the merged group is ONE group) must be in attendance before entering the retreat.

CHAPERONES are...

- 21 years and older, must be verified by the parish Safe Environment Coordinator.
- Must stay with students the entire retreat, 6:00 pm Friday 1:00 pm Sunday. All day and all night.
- Aware of the students in their group and student whereabouts during the retreat.
- Prepared to lead small groups.
- Aware of the medical needs of students and properly dispense meds to individuals in the group.
- Required to stay on the premises for the entire retreat.
- Cannot leave to attend to other obligations and return.
- The Presence Committee will not secure chaperones for your group. If you connect with another group to share chaperones, then you merge as a group. All the forms and fees should be mailed under ONE group name. Upon arrival at the retreat, everyone in your group (the merged group is ONE group) must be in attendance before entering the retreat.
